- Design and develop modules and programs reflecting the latest subject developments, ensuring alignment with University QA policies and regulatory body requirements.



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- Create teaching content informed by current research, practice, and industry knowledge to foster critical, rational, and creative thinking in students.
- Design appropriate assessment that is aligned with learning outcomes, maintaining standards and adhering to timelines.
- Assess students' work against learning objectives, monitor progress, and provide timely and effective feedback in line with university quality standards.
- Provide support and counselling to students, including supervising undergraduate and postgraduate dissertations and projects.
- Offer pastoral and academic care, giving first-line support and referring students to professional services when necessary.
- Enhance teaching practice through self-reflection and feedback to review effectiveness and implement improvements.
- Contribute to teaching design and delivery improvements, actively engaging in quality monitoring and enhancement processes.
