- Design and update module content and assessments in English and Translation to reflect the latest advancements in the field, aligning with University quality policies.
- Implement appropriate assessment methods to meet targeted learning outcomes; provide timely, constructive feedback.
- Supervise undergraduate and postgraduate dissertations and projects, particularly in Translation specialisations such as Technical Translation, Translation Tools and Technologies.
- Foster an engaging learning environment, encouraging students to achieve their full potential.

Research:

- Conduct research and scholarly activities in English and Translation, with a focus on specialised areas.
- Ensure research outputs contribute to teaching quality and benefit students, the University, and the broader Kurdistan Region.
- Disseminate research findings through presentations, academic conferences, workshops, and publications.
- Write and submit grant applications, project reports, and journal articles to secure research funding and recognition.

Administration:

- Participate actively in academic and administrative committees at the School and University levels.
- Assist in developing and coordinating undergraduate and postgraduate programmes/modules.
- Support quality assurance and enhancement processes, ensuring consistency in teaching standards and performance.
- Organise and prioritise work and resources to achieve objectives, monitor action plans, and plan CPD activities.
